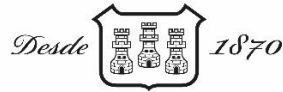

STATEMENT ON COVID-19

Royal Decree Law 10/2020, of March 29, issued by the Spanish Government, regulates total confinement except for essential services until April 9 in the fight against COVID-19. It considers essential activities those involved in the market supply chain and in the provision of services for producers of essential goods and services, including food and beverage.

Therefore, as ratified by the Spanish Wine Federation (FEV), wineries and businesses in the wine sector can continue to work with the health restrictions and safety measures established by Royal Decree Lay 463/2020, of March 14. This also applies to auxiliary industry and transport.

Familia Torres wishes to make the following statement:

- We keep our business running.
- Our production capacity has not been significantly altered for the time being, although it is limited due to the safety precautions and our suppliers' circumstances.
- We are following the protocols established in line with the recommendations from the health authorities to minimize the risk of contagion and protect the health of our employees, suppliers, distributors and clients.
- In the departments where remote working is not possible, we have established working groups and strict safety measures (temperature check upon entering the facilities, minimum distance between workers, stepping up the cleaning and disinfection of spaces and machinery, etc.) to guarantee business continuity.

We are hopeful that this unprecedented emergency situation will end soon. In the meantime, we will continue working to the best of our abilities. Thank you for your understanding and commitment to the fight against COVID-19.
